Re: Boarding of Grain Vessels / AGM Vessels at Anchor


This letter serves as a reminder that any vessel used as a launch is required to standby while CFIA inspectors are onboard the vessel, as outlined in the attached memorandum to the BC Chamber of Shipping.

Please note that in the event the launch is required to leave the vessel, regardless of reason, all the Inspectors conducting work on the vessel are to be notified immediately by the Agent prior to the launch leaving, and that all inspection tasks will be stopped until the launch returns.

In the event the weather turns or the launch is delayed for an indeterminate time, it will be the agent's responsibility to ensure another launch is available to pick up the Inspection team. This is to ensure the safety of the inspection staff, in the event of injury.
